

Process to check the qualifications of the centre's assessor and the procedure followed

The specialist centre assessor is appointed by the Head of centre.

The specialist assessor must either be:

- A qualified Psychologist registered with the Health & Care Professions Council (HCPC)
- A specialist assessor with a current SpLD Assessment Practising Certificate, awarded by BDA
- A specialist assessor with a post-graduate qualification in individual specialist assessment at or equivalent to Level 7.

The Head of Centre will check that the centre's specialist assessor's qualifications meet the JCQ required levels.

Our school's specialist assessor is Jeanette Mansell, who holds an award with Patoss having successfully completed a AAA: Assessing for Access Arrangements post-graduate course at or equivalent to Level 7, including at least 100 hours relating to individual specialist assessment.

The original certificate has been seen by the Head of Centre and a copy is held on file with the Exams Officer.
