

Short Stay Sports Day

The day started with the Long Jump with Kye Bell powerfully leaping to victory, closely followed by Connor Evans in second place.

There was victory in the boys Shot Putt for Lexx Brahim, whilst last-minute entrant Liam Hunt finished in third place in a large and competitive field. Kettlebrook also secured first place in the girls shot putt, with Zoe Biggs producing a great series of throws.

The blue riband event of the 100m then saw Lexx win his second gold medal of the day. Ellis Grey finished the strongly in second place.

The next event was the 200m with Lex completing a hat trick of victories, following a blistering start on the bend.

The two lap race was won impressively by Kye Bell with a well-judged run, finishing strongly against a determined opponent in the home straight.

The meet concluded with the traditional 4x100m, where the KSSS quartet of Connor Evans, Liam Hunt, Lexx Brahim and Kye Bell safely got the baton around and gained victory against a competitive Bridge team. This meant that Lexx added a 4th gold medal to complete his tally and Kye ended the day with three winner's medals.
