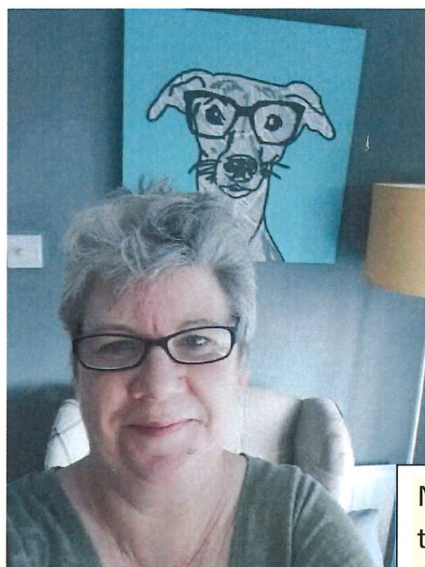

Our very own Mrs Lawton will **BRAVE THE SHAVE** to raise funds! **Sponsor form in school.**

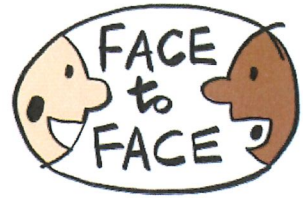
Move over Emma Raducanu and her tennis win! Mr Sims completed the North Run in 1 hour 26 mins And he's still smiling!

3. Listen carefully – and show you have by asking questions.

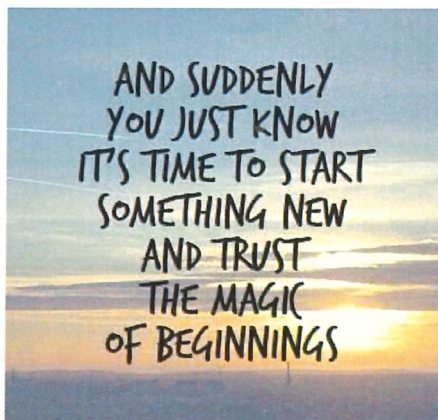


4. Maintain trust – don't 'chat' behind their back or share their feelings/stories/secrets to others.
