Things to consider: 2022-23 cohort

- Over 70% of Yr 11 leavers from KSSS were permanently excluded.

- The students will rarely get all the suggest guided learning hours for any of the qualifications due to arriving at different points to KSSS.
- 70% of our students will have had at least one or more professional agency involved.
- Over 90% of our students get their first choice as their POST 16 destinations – Apprenticeships; College and then onto University.
- COVID affected education provision before arriving at KSSS; increased barriers to learning and reduced social skills, increase in mental health issues.
