*FE and provider visits and meetings are promoted to all students during their 1:1 guidance appointment's. Multiple visits are advised. For a number of students, individual tours/meetings and visits are arranged with providers prior to applications being submitted (this is a need's led process). Transitional support is critical for students from the SSS who often have a complex relationship with education.

**Each year group has a pack of activities which are targeted towards career information and development, self-exploration and motivation. Packs are designed to be delivered flexibly across year groups (delivery period can change) and each pack builds upon the previous year. Packs can be transferred to new education providers for continued careers work.
