I have been the Head of School at Kettlebrook and have worked closely with the Executive Headteacher (who has over 15 years' experience at Kettlebrook). I am so proud to lead and manage our small Pupil Referral Unit – especially as most of our students will achieve positive destinations – whether it is returning to mainstream, onto other AP or POST 16 destinations which cover: A Levels; Level 1 and 2 courses at College; Apprenticeships; Employment. On average 95% of our Year 11 leavers secure their chosen destination of their first choice. All students have access to our careers programme per week and then by Year 11 there are many 1-1 meetings and discussions with staff and our excellent Careers Advisor – who has 20 years' experience and knowledge of the work places in Tamworth. Kettlebrook was the first PRU in the Country to receive the Quality in Careers Standards award and it is because we put careers at the heart of curriculum and holistic offer.
