MOCK INTERVIEW NOTES

Interviews should last approx. 10/15 minutes per student with 5 minute direct feedback time

Opening the interview:

- Introduce yourself as the interviewer
- Explain to the student that the interview will last about 10 minutes with 5 minutes feedback
- Explain that this interview will include some competency based questions which require them to give specific examples where possible. Explain that this is a common form of assessment in interviews and is the opportunity to demonstrate to the interviewer past experiences where they have demonstrated a particular skill.
- Try to ensure that they relax and enjoy the experience as much as possible

Opening Questions – The candidate may be bring a CV or Personal Statement.

- 1. Please start by telling me a little bit about yourself and your career aspirations
- 2. What do you think makes a good [insert the career they are interested in]
- 3. What do you feel are your biggest strengths?
- 4. What do you feel is your biggest weakness? How do you manage your weakness?

Competency Based Questions

- 1. Can you tell me about a time where you worked as a team to achieve a task? What made it good?
- 2. Can you tell me about a time when you motivated others to achieve a task? How did you do it?
- 3. Can you tell me about a time where you used your own initiative?
- 4. Can you tell me about a time when you experienced a setback? What happened and how did you recover?
- 5. Can you tell me about a time when you had to work to a tough deadline? How did you manage that?
- 6. Have you any questions you want to ask?
